Requirements:

The following must be met for eligibility:

- 1.) High School Senior who has participated in at least 1 JA program in high school.
- 2.) Must have a minimum final GPA of 3.0
- 3.) Provide 1 Teacher recommendation
- 4.) Must provide verification of JA program participation from school or JA coordinator
- 5.) Provide a copy of high school transcripts or most recent report card (2 Quarters)
- 6.) Complete an application form, including a typed 250-300 word essay answering the question:

How has your JA experience increased your understanding of the importance of all people being financially literate?

How can you promote the value of financial literacy in your community?

Students must send the above information postmarked no later than Friday, April 18, 2025 to:
